AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS, DESIGNATING THE OAK HEIGHTS LIVE OAK TREE AS A HISTORIC LANDMARK, AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City Council finds that the Oak Heights Live Oak Tree located in the 500 block of Franklin Drive:

- 1. Has historical and cultural significance.
- 2. Is suitable for preservation.
- 3. Has educational value.


SECTION 2. That the Oak Heights Live Oak Tree located in the 500 block of Franklin Drive is hereby designated as a historic landmark.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall be in effect ten (10) days from and after its passage, and it shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the area as required by the Charter of the City of San Marcos, Texas.

PASSED, APPROVED AND ADOPTED July 14, 1986.




