The City of San Marcos is seeking volunteers to mark storm drains and inlets with the marker above!

Anything that enters our storm drains and inlets does not get filtered or treated and travels directly to streams, creeks and rivers. The San Marcos River is an extremely unique waterbody that provides habitat to threatened and endangered species including the Fountain Darter, Texas Wild Rice, the Texas Blind Salamander and the San Marcos Salamander.

Volunteer efforts will be centered in neighborhoods and low traffic areas and installing the markers is very easy. During this volunteer event, some volunteers will install the markers, and others will place informational door hangers on doors within the neighborhood. If you choose to volunteer, you will be a steward of water quality and protecting our beautiful San Marcos River!
