## Discussion and Purpose:

*Vision San Marcos: A River Runs Through Us*, the City's Comprehensive Plan was adopted in April of 2013. Since adoption, the only amendments to the plan have been owner initiated requests to amend the Intensity Zones on the Preferred Scenario Map.

Two main objectives of the Comprehensive Plan were identified as key components for implementation and began almost immediately following adoption:

- 1) Rewrite the Land Development Code (CodeSMTX)
- 2) Update the Transportation Master Plan

New and valuable information identified during these projects coupled with significant transportation infrastructure improvements and flooding that has occurred in recent years trigger the need for an update to the City's Comprehensive Plan. The purpose of this update will be to incorporate this new information and maintain a current tool for guiding growth and development in San Marcos. Staff is proposing that this update begin after the adoption of Code SMTX and the Transportation Master Plan.

## Interim Update to the Preferred Scenario Map

Code SMTX and the Transportation Master Plan processes have identified several interim amendments to the Preferred Scenario Map that will be proposed with the adoption of these projects. These interim amendments include:

- 1) Land Use: Identify and differentiate each Neighborhood Study Area on the Preferred Scenario Map and include a new category on the map called Existing Neighborhood Area.
- 2) Transportation: Refinement of identified major transportation corridors and the inclusion of corridor classifications including Highway Corridors, and Conservation Corridors on the Preferred Scenario Map. Refinement of the identified greenways corridors to match the adopted Greenways Master Plan

## Progress towards Objectives Report

Attached is a document containing all of the *Vision San Marcos* Objectives with a list of all of the related projects that were initiated after the adoption of the Comprehensive Plan in 2013. This document was used as the basis for the Oversight Committee's Report to City Council.

Staff held internal workshops to discuss the status of projects associated with the Comprehensive Plan objectives. Project status includes:

ACTIVE indicates that the project has begun and that the project is intended to have a completion date.

ONGOING indicates that various projects or initiatives have begun and are intended to continue into the future without a defined completion date.

COMPLETE indicates that the project is complete.

FUTURE indicates that a project is intended to begin within the next 1 – 2 years.

A handful of projects directly address a significant number of Comprehensive Plan Objectives in more than one Comprehensive Plan element. The attached presentation highlights those projects that are complete or active.
