I have read, understand, and agree to the following program guidelines:

- Program participants must be City of San Marcos single-family residential water customers with an account in good standing.
- Rebated toilets must be new EPA WaterSense models, and must replace existing high-volume toilets or standard low-flow toilets.
- Toilets must be installed in the City of San Marcos water service area, and must remain at the original installation address for the lifetime of the toilet.
- Program participant is responsible for disposing of old toilet(s) in a manner to prevent re-use.
- A dated and itemized sales receipt must be provided with the application. Receipts dated more than 90 days from the current date will not qualify for a rebate.
- Prior to issuance of a rebate check, a site inspection may be conducted to verify toilet installation. The toilet must be installed and functional at the time of the inspection.
- Rebates are offered on a first come/first serve basis, and are subject to availability of funds.
- The rebated amount may include the cost of parts (toilet tank and bowl only) and labor up to a maximum of: \$100 per toilet for replacing high-volume models installed before 1994; \$25 per toilet for replacing standard low-flow models installed 1994 and after.
- Participants may be required to complete a follow up questionnaire.
- Qualifying products were selected on the basis of water efficiency only. The City of San Marcos does not endorse specific brands, products, or dealers; nor does it guarantee materials, workmanship, performance or durability of rebated toilets.
