Rules & Regulations

ALL HORSES AND MULES MUST HAVE A CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH AND MAY NOT RUN LOOSE.

- *No riding double except for adults with young children
- *Stay off the pavement where possible and away from traffic
- "No riding bareback, trick riding or roping.
- "No littering, cursing or fighting
- *No firearms and no drinking horseback
- *Uncontrollable horses are not allowed on the ride
- *Red ribbons will be furnished for horses that kick
- *Anyone getting out of hand, will be asked to leave the ride
- *Vehicles are not allowed to follow the ride
- *Keep all campfires small and extinguish them before leaving.
- *Parents make sure their child has an adult to ride with.
- *Generators should be muffled and of reasonable noise level.
- *Do not play loud music when staying up late at night

Directions

From Austin or San Antonio: Take Exit 205 and turn west on Hopkins. Go 2.1 miles and turn right on Ranch Road 12 toward Wimberley. Go 4.3 miles RR 12 and watch for the Freeman Ranch sign. Turn right on County Road 213. Go 2.1 miles on County Road 213 and watch for a Freeman Ranch sign. Turn right into ranch and go .7 miles; follow road to camp site. See you there!!
