

Awesome Bracelets or Cuffs



Supplies Needed:

shown:

used tape tube,
multiple small bits of yarn

not shown:

double sided tape, scissors,
felt shape and glue



1. Stick double sided tape all the way around on the inside of the old tape tube. You can use glue but it is a little sticky.

2. Start wrapping the yarn around the tube. Leave a tail so that you can tie a knot when you have completed the wrapping.



3. When you get close to the end of your yarn, tie a knot on the inside of the tube so it can be hidden. Leave the tied ends hanging on the tube side. When you wrap the next color, the ends will be covered up.

Tie a knot and leave the ends like this.

The ends get covered up.





4. Keep wrapping until you arrive at the beginning. Tie a double knot using the ending yarn and the beginning yarn. Your wrapped bracelet or cuff is now complete. Give yourself a pat on the back.

If you want a special shape on your bracelet or cuff you can cut something out of felt or fabric and glue it on.
