

# Fiesta Flags

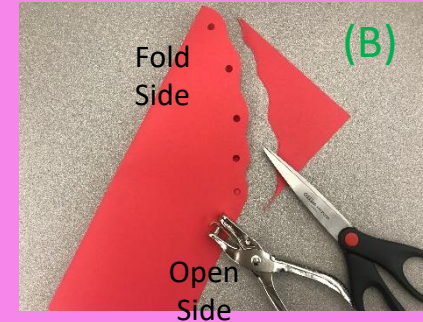
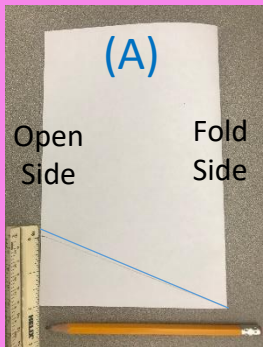
## Supplies:

- \*Ribbon
- \*Tape, Ruler, Markers
- \*Hole Punch, Scissors, Stapler
- \*Letter size paper, 2 different colors

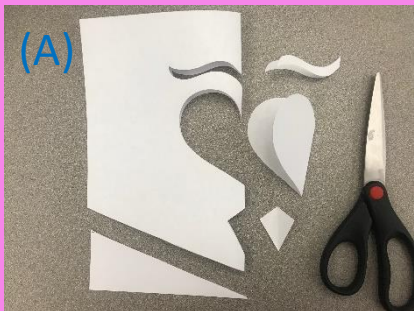


1. Fold both pieces of paper on the long side.

2. With the top piece of paper (A) measure 2 inches on the open side. Draw an angle from the 2 inch mark to the tip of the folded side. You just made a right triangle.



3. Cut out your triangle and then cut some shapes on the folded side.



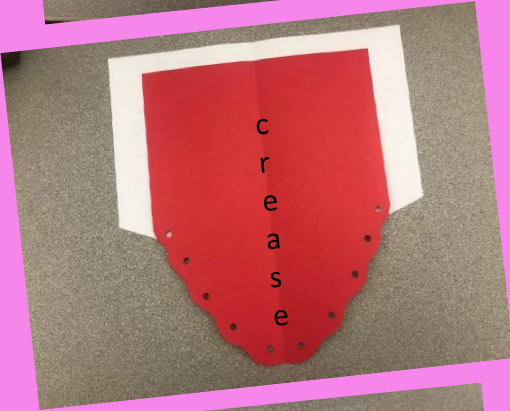
4. Now, on paper (B) cut a curvy line from the open side to the tip of the folded side. My start point was about 4 inches up on the open side. I made some hole punch designs too.



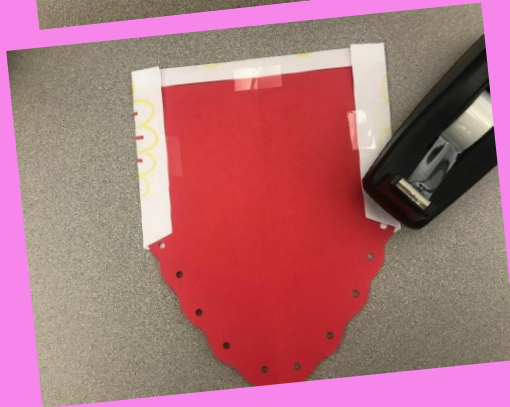
5. Next, open up paper (A) and draw some designs around your cut out shapes.



6. Flip paper (A) over then put paper (B) on top while lining up the crease with each other.



7. Fold the corners of paper (A) around paper (B) and tape. If you want to make a row of flags, tape or staple them together with ribbon.



The Take and Make Fiesta Flags are made with fabric and paper. The only difference between the two is the fabric is stapled to the paper where as the paper to paper flag is taped.

Either way works for making some *Fabulous Fiesta Flags!*
