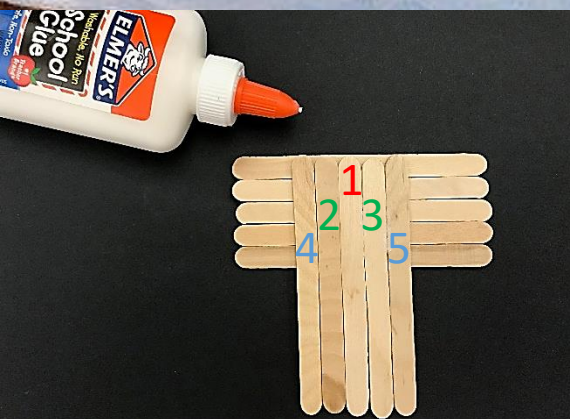


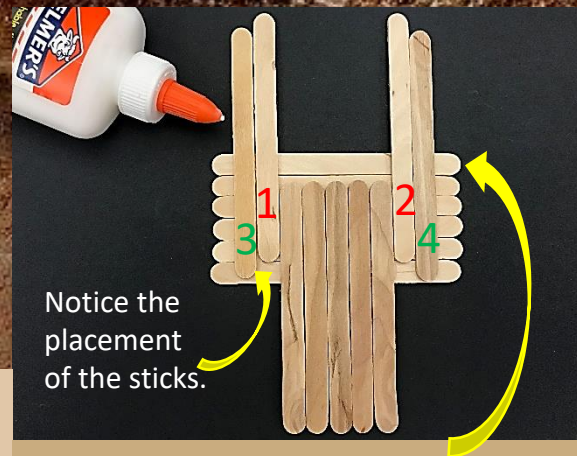
LLAMA CRAFT

Supplies:

- 15 Popsicle Sticks
- Brown Construction Paper cut into a 2 1/2 in diameter circle
- Yarn
- Glue and a Pen



1. Lay 5 popsicle sticks horizontally and close together. Then, start gluing the (1) middle popsicle stick first. Lay it perpendicular to the horizontal sticks then proceed to glue and lay the other sticks in numerical order as shown.



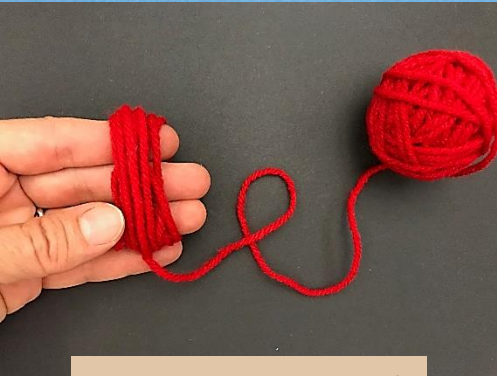
Notice the placement of the sticks.

2. Lay one popsicle stick on the top of the horizontal sticks so that row becomes 6 sticks. Next, glue the llama ears proceeding numerically as shown. Let it dry.



3. Turn your llama over and glue the brown circle on the horizontal sticks. Next draw the nose and the eyes.

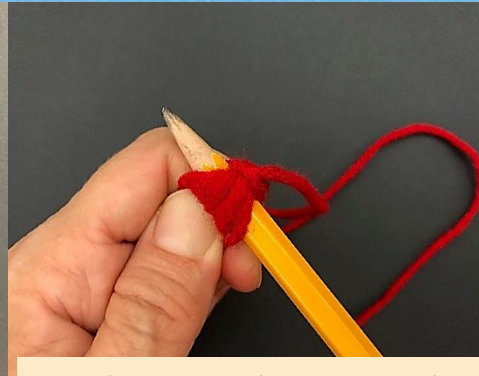
TASSEL FOR THE LLAMA



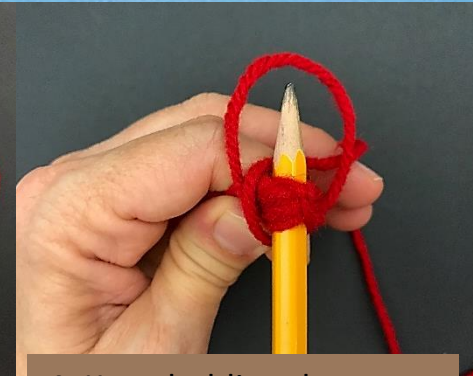
1. Wrap yarn around your three fingers 10 times and cut an 8 in. tail.



2. Next, take your fingers out and thread the end of the yarn through the hole and make a knot. The knot will be on the top.



3. Take a pencil or pen and put it through the hole. Use your fingers as a clamp to hold the yarn tight on the opposite side of the knot.



4. Keep holding the yarn tight and use your other hand to wrap the tail around the yarn at the top of your fingers. Then tie a knot.



5. This is what it looks like after you have tied a knot 2 times.



6. For the yarn tail to be coming off the top, put the tail through the tiny hole where the pencil was and make a knot similar to the picture.
