

# Back to School Owl

## Supplies:

- Yarn, about 25 wraps around your hand
- Cardboard, 2 in. x 2 ½ in.
- Two 1 ½ in. circles cut out of colorful paper with a hole punched in the center
- A 3 x 1 ¼ in. piece of card stock paper for the tail and beak
- 1 pipe cleaner, 2 feathers
- Ruler, Scissors, Glue
- Pencil for the owl to sit on

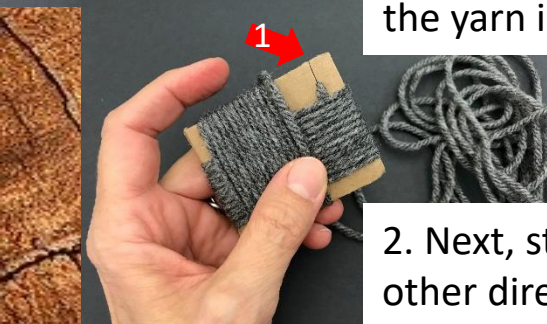
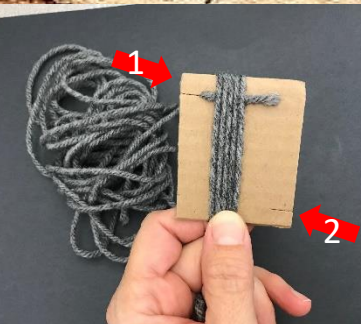


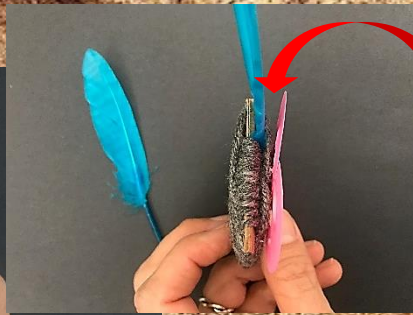
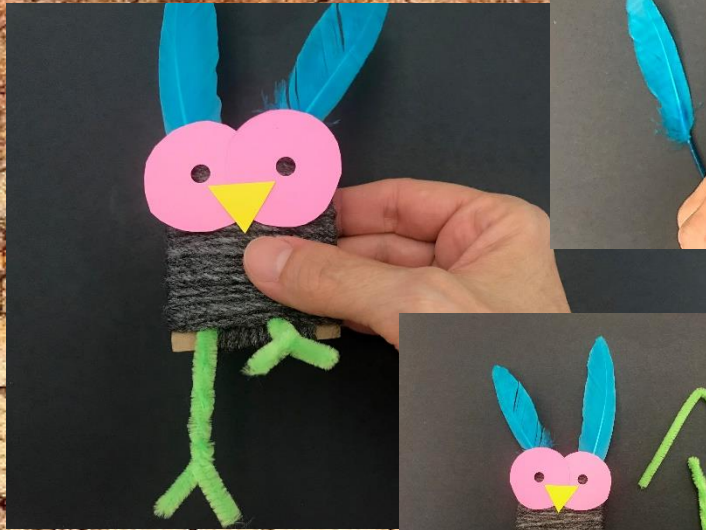
1. Cut 2 slits on opposite sides of the cardboard. Next, slip the end of the yarn into (1) slit and wrap the yarn around the cardboard until you get to the (2) slit. Slip the yarn into the (2) slit.

2. Next, start wrapping in the other direction until you get to (1) slit. Slip the yarn into (1) slit and cut a 1 inch tail.

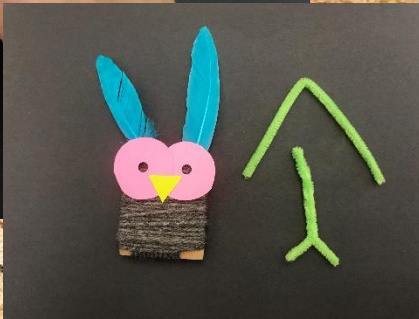
3. Tuck the tail into the top of the wrapped yarn. Next, glue the two circles and beak together.

4. Glue the owl face onto the yarn body. (use a lot of glue and let it dry). Then, cut the pipe cleaner in half for the owl's two legs.

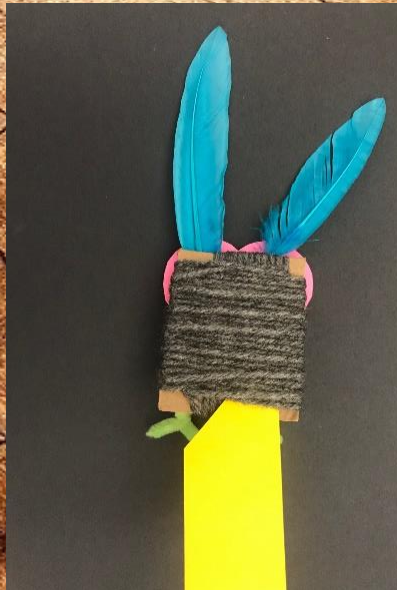




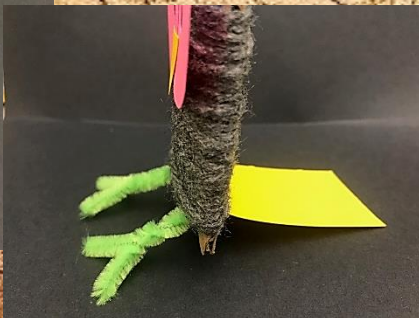
5. Stick the feathers into the yarn behind the owl's eyes.



6. Next, make the legs by bending the pipe cleaner in half and twisting from the bend down. Make sure to leave some untwisted for the feet. Then, slip the legs under the yarn.



7. For the tail, cut an angle in the paper so it can easily slip between the yarn on the owl's back. Bend the tail so the owl can sit than slip a pencil under the legs so your owl looks like it is perching. 😊
