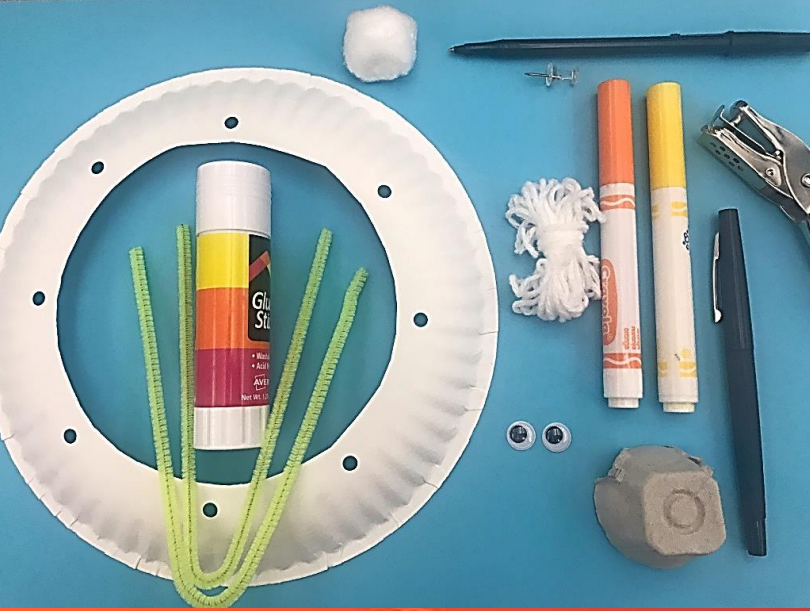


## Growing Up Wild: *Spider Craft* Instructions

### Supplies:

- Paper Plate
- Pipe Cleaners
- Yarn
- A Cotton Ball
- Egg Carton Cup
- Scissors, Hole Punch
- Black Pens, Markers
- Push Pin ( Adult Helper)



1. Cut one cup out of an egg carton (this will be the body of the spider). **Adult Helper** Poke eight holes into the body with the push pin. This will be the holes for the legs. To widen the holes poke the tip of a ball point pen into the small holes.



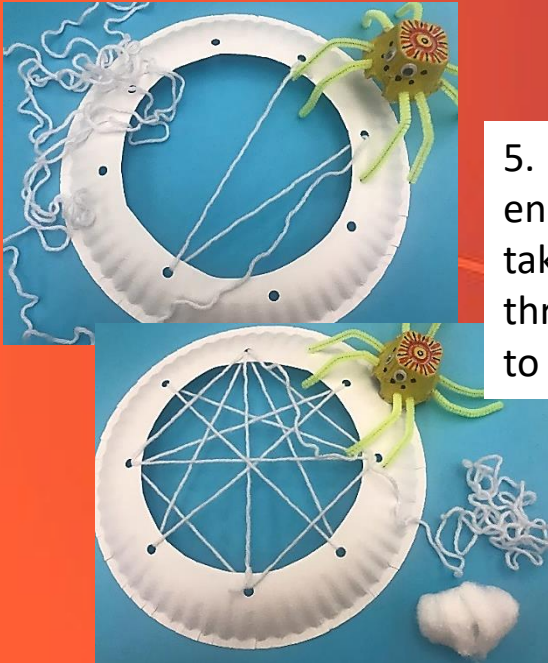
2. Use your markers to color the spiders' body. After that, cut the pipe cleaners into four equal pieces.



3. Next, thread the pipe cleaners through the holes. After that, glue on the google eyes. Then, draw six more eyes so the spider has a total of eight eyes.



4. To make the web, start with cutting the inner circle out of the plate. Once the circle is cut out, punch eight holes around the inner circle.



5. Next, take the yarn and tie one end around one of the holes. Then, take the other end and start threading it through different holes to create a crisscross pattern.



6. Once you've crisscrossed enough, leave some yarn to wind around a cotton ball to create a wrapped meal for the spider or her wrapped egg sac.



You get to decide what your spider is doing. 😊
