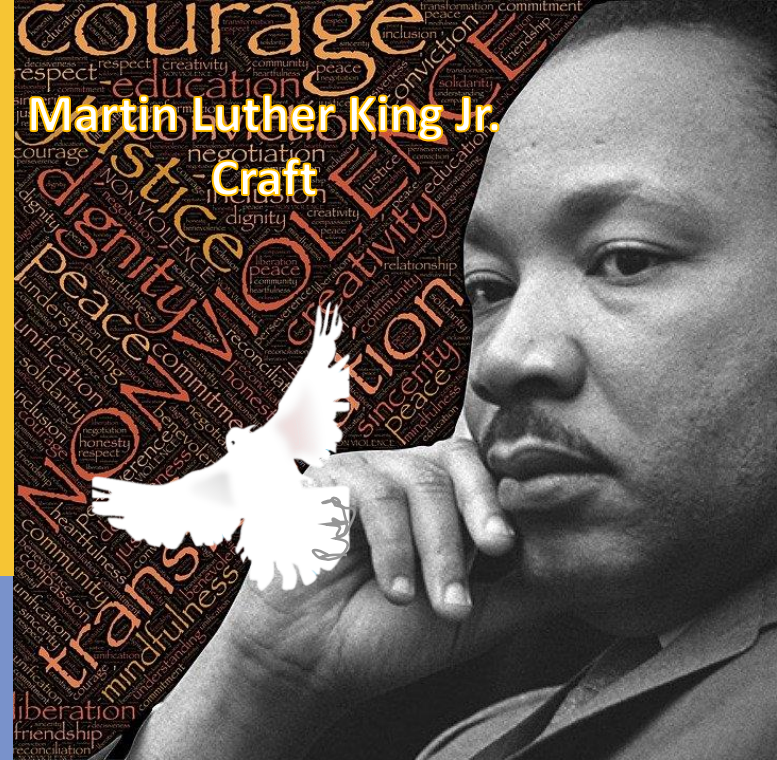




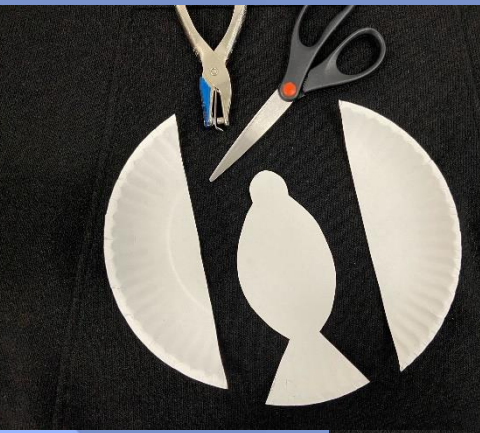
Supplies:

- * Paper Plate
- * Crepe Paper Streamers (2 colors)
- * piece of paper that has “I have a dream” written on it
- * 12 inches of yarn
- * tape, glue, stapler
- * pen, yellow colored pencil
- * scissors, hole punch



Martin Luther King Jr. Craft

1. Draw a dove body in the middle of the plate. Draw the two wings on either side of the dove. Cut out the dove and then use the hole punch to make a hole at the top of the dove's head. (This is for the hanger)



2. Next, staple the wings to the body.



3. Glue the “I have a dream” piece of paper to the chest of the dove, then draw the face with the pen and color in the beak with the yellow pencil.



4. Cut the streamers around 24 inches. Then, flip the dove to the back side and tape the streamers.



5. Thread the yarn through the hole and tie. Swing the dove and remember Dr. King's words.
